"On Monday, January 4th, both chambers finally released a final compromise version of the climate Roadmap Bill: S.2995. The coalition celebrated the inclusion of environmental justice in particular, the creation of a net zero stretch building code, and giving municipalities greater control over the quality and efficiency of new construction projects. The bill builds upon the 2008's Global Warming Solutions Act by creating interim carbon emissions targets for 2030, 2035, 2040 and 2045 as well as 'sub limits' for major sectors (e.g. electric power, transportation, heating

Elizabeth Chen, PhD, MBA, MPH began her tenure as Secretary of the Massachusetts Executive Office of Elder Affairs (EOEA) on June 3, 2019. Dr. Chen previously served as an Assistant Commissioner of the Massachusetts Department of Public Health (DPH). At DPH, she oversaw the licensing of over 300,000 health care professionals and over 4,500 hospitals, clinics, nursing homes, ambulances and other mobile care units. She is also a member of Pilgrim Church.
